UDPATE FROM KENYA

- ★ It has been reported in the media that Kenya has been affected by drought in the past few weeks and so life is becoming harder for the people there due to lack of water, crop failure & food shortages.
- Friends of Londiani Ireland has now an official sister charity in Kenya (Friends of Londiani, Kenya). Friends of Londiani Kenya achieved NGO status (Non Governmental Organisation) last November. This is great news as it will allow us to manage our work in Kenya even more efficiently and effectively in the future.
- ★ The children in the Bethel Faith home in Londiani received Christmas presents again this year from Brownies and Guides in Ireland. The children were very excited on Christmas day to receive all the gifts. Thank you to all those units involved in this project.
- ★ Ndubusat Primary School is almost finished its renovations and the official opening of the classrooms will be happening in February.
- ★ The Ndubusat hospital work is continuing and the six wards are now ready for patients. Work has begun on other necessary hospital buildings.
- ★ The HIV/AIDS peer education groups are growing daily and a lot of men are now involved as well. Our coordinator of the groups in Kenya has been working very hard keeping everything on track. It is great to see that the work originally started in 2002 is now blossoming in such a huge way.
- ★ The children in the home are all well and two of the older girls have now started in third level education one as a Science Teacher and the other as a Nurse. These girls' education is funded by the donations received by Friends of Londiani, Ireland.
- ★ The Headmaster and students of Ndubusat Primary School would like to say thank you to all those who helped make their school into a "fantastic place to learn".
- ★ The Staff of Ndubusat Hospital and the Ndubusat Community are very grateful for the hospital buildings and programmes put in place by FOL.
- ★ The water project in Ndubusat is a big success bringing water to many people every day.
- ★ Many project proposals have been received from local people by FOL for the future and will be considered for our Kenya Project in 2007.

Footprints To Kenya



Footprints to Kenya - the Friends of Londiani Four Peaks challenge will start on Friday, 2nd June when the team leaves Dublin for Glasgow. The team will complete Ben Nevis in Scotland and Scafell Pyke in the Lake District on Saturday, Snowdon in Wales on Sunday. They will then return to Ireland to complete Carrauntohill in Kerry on Monday.

The team consists of 40 Irish people from all over Ireland. They have begun training and hope to complete the 4 peaks in the given time period.

STANDING ORDERS

Many people have asked us to provide the opportunity to donate by Standing Order as it is easier for them than a once off payment. Please pass this onto anyone else you know who may be interested.

Welcome to the "Friends of Londiani, Ireland" Standing Order Appeal.

Since it inception in 2002, the mission of Friends of Londiani is to work in partnership with the people of Londiani, and its surrounding villages to develop and complete sustainable community projects to enable and empower the people to achieve an improved quality of life based on their values and become the authors of their own development. The Friends of Londiani will endeavour to achieve these goals in a spirit of cooperation and mutual respect with one another and with the people of the area. This partnership will enable members of Friends of Londiani to further develop skills and a deeper cultural understanding.

What will your money do?

There are many advantages to donating to the Friends of Londiani:

- It will allow us to continue to provide necessary funds for the education of the children in the Bethel Faith Home and Training Centre in Londiani.
- It will enable us to continue to work with communities in Kenya and provide essential medical care for them.
- It will allow us to continue to support Irish volunteers going to Kenya to work on projects there.

How much do you have to donate?

You can donate any amount of money on a monthly basis and all donations are gratefully received.

For example if you donate €5 a month, you will have paid for a child's educational fees.

If you donate €21 a month, you are actually giving much more as we can claim Tax Relief Benefits so your €21 a month could actually bring €431 to the charity (see below).

Tax Relief Benefits

Under the tax relief for Designated Charities scheme Friends of Londiani can obtain a refund on the tax paid by individuals who are taxed under the PAYE tax system.

This means the value of your donation will be increased, for example if you donate at least €250 (minimum qualifying amount) in the tax year and paid tax at a rate of 42%, Friends of Londiani is entitled to a repayment of €181 making your total donation €431. Similarly the total value of a donation if you paid tax at a rate of 20% is €312.50.

The Revenue Commissioners have produced a **CHY2 Certificate** to fill out. This applies to individuals who are assessed for tax under PAYE. The CHY2 form is available at http://www.revenue.ie/doc/chy2.doc
